

2007 APPLICATION TO ENTER CHAMPIONS TOUR QUALIFYING TOURNAMENT

Regional Qualifying: October 28 – November 2
Final Qualifying: November 11 – 16

ENTRY DEADLINE: OCTOBER 10, 2007 at 5:00 P.M. EDT

Completely executed entry applications must reach PGA TOUR Headquarters by 5:00p.m. EDT, October 10, 2007 without exception. Incomplete, late, or entries by facsimile, telephone or email will NOT be accepted.

The undersigned must be a professional or amateur golfer highly skilled who is at least 50 years of age, or turn 50 on or before April 28, 2008. A certified birth certificate must accompany this entry. Amateurs who meet the above age criteria are entitled to enter the National Qualifying Tournament subject to completion of item #9 of this application.

The undersigned hereby applies to enter the **2007 Champions Tour National Qualifying Tournament**. Although this competition will be a determinant of access to Event Qualifying for Champions Tour open full-field tournaments, PGA TOUR reserves the right to apply reasonable criteria other than performance in this competition (including, but not limited to, character, conduct, financial responsibility, etc.) to all applicants for entry . Based on all such factors, PGA TOUR in its sole discretion will determine whether to extend the undersigned an invitation to participate in Champions Tour Event Qualifiers.

If the undersigned agrees to accept such invitation to participate in Champions Tour Event Qualifiers, the player agrees to pay the fees and dues and to abide by the *Tournament Regulations* of the Champions Tour in consideration of all the rights and privileges of such access.

The undersigned also understands that this application may at any time be rejected (including during the Qualifying Tournament) by PGA TOUR. Conduct unbecoming a professional or noncompetitive performance in previous Champions Tour tournaments or any level of the Champions Tour National Qualifying Tournament may be a basis for the rejection of an application.

PGA TOUR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE THE QUALIFYING TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND SCHEDULE FROM THAT PRESENTLY CONTEMPLATED.

FORMAT AND SCHEDULE OF PLAY

I. REGIONAL QUALIFYING COMPETITION

There are four sites for Regional competitions scheduled for a field of 78, with no cut, to be played over 72 holes. If a player is determined to be noncompetitive by Tournament Officials on-site managing any stage of the Qualifying Tournament, PGA TOUR reserves the right to remove said player from the competition, without any refund of entry fee. The number of players to advance from each Regional site to the Finals will be on a pro rata basis from each Regional competition determined after taking into account players automatically eligible for the finals of the National Qualifying Tournament, and will be announced prior to the commencement of Regional Qualifying. PGA TOUR shall assign a Tournament Official on-site at the Regional who shall appoint a Rules Committee. The Rules Committee's decisions shall be final.

Golf Cart Policy at Regionals: Carts will be permitted in practice and competitive rounds. Refer to page 4 section "F" for details.

Practice Rounds: November 11-12 (Sun.- Mon.)

Tournament Rounds: November 13-16 (Tues.-Fri.)

Field and Format: Finals will consist of 4 rounds and 72-holes, no cut. The starting field will be 78 players, inclusive of the 2007 Senior PGA Professional National Championship exemptions (“a” below); and the two international exemptions (“b” & “c” below). PGA TOUR reserves the right to add players to the field of 78 at the Final Qualifying stage.

Golf Cart Policy: Carts will be permitted in practice and competitive rounds. Refer to page 4 section “F” for details.

Exemptions: The following applicants shall be exempt into the Finals of the National Qualifying Tournament provided their entry fee is paid-in-full and received by the October 10th entry deadline.

- a. The top ten finishers (positions # 1 - # 10) in the 2007 Senior PGA Professional National Championship.
- b. The leading available player (to a floor of fifth position) on the 2007 European Seniors Tour Order of Merit through October 22, 2007.
- c. The leading available player (to a floor of fifth position) on the 2007 PGA of Japan Seniors Tour Order of Merit through October 22, 2007.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money of \$200,000 will be distributed among the top 30 finishers and those tied for 30th place at the Champions Tour National Qualifying Final Tournament.

ENTRY FEE: \$2,500 (Regional and/or Finals)

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY FEE/NOTICE OF REGIONAL SITE: Notification of acceptance into the Qualifying Tournament will be sent upon receipt of entry and full fee. Notification of assignment to a Regional site will be sent in a timely manner after the entry deadline.

PGA TOUR IS NOT RESPONSIBLE for timely delivery by the U.S. Postal Service OR any overnight carrier. It is the applicant's responsibility to contact Champions Tour Headquarters to verify receipt and status in Regional Qualifying sites. All entries sent without the full entry fee and certified birth certificate, or otherwise incomplete, will be returned.

III. Champions Tour Eligibility/Tournament Access

Access to the Event Qualifying competitions preceding all Champions Tour open, full-field tournaments will be awarded to the top 30 finishers, and those tied for 30th place from the Final stage of the National Qualifying Tournament.

Up to nine low scorers in each Event Qualifier will be provided entry into the Champions Tour tournament for which the Event Qualifier is played.

A maximum of two (2) players finishing in 10th place (including ties for 10th place) or better in the order of finish in the immediately preceding Champions Tour cosponsored event will gain entry into the next succeeding open, full-field tournament. In such instance, the number of available positions within the Event Qualifier will be reduced by the commensurate amount.

In the last four full-field, cosponsored Champions Tour tournaments of the year, a minimum of four players will receive access in open, full-field, cosponsored tournaments from the pool of available players 75th or better on the current year's Champions Tour official money list not otherwise exempt. In these events, the number of available positions at each Event Qualifier will be reduced to five.

Note: Players finishing tied for 30th or better in the final stage of the National Qualifying Tournament shall be eligible to apply for Champions Tour Associate Membership for the 2008 season.

IV. WITHDRAWALS, SUBSTITUTIONS AND REALLOTMENT OF SPOTS

- A. Entry fees shall not be refunded unless illness or extreme circumstances prevent qualifying play, in which case a request for a refund, along with valid proof of illness or other extreme circumstances must be substantiated in writing. Refunds will not be processed until written substantiation of withdrawal is received. A \$150 processing fee will automatically be deducted from all approved entry fee refunds. **Once an entrant has started in any qualifying stage (regionals/finals), no refunds of entry fee will be provided. NOTE: Only withdrawals made personally by the applicant will be accepted.**
- B. If a successful Regional Qualifying stage entrant withdraws prior to such entrant beginning play in the Final Qualifying stage, the first available alternate from the same Regional Qualifying stage site will be substituted.
- C. If an applicant automatically eligible into the Final Qualifying stage withdraws before all Regional stage contestants have teed off, the position reserved will be reallocated to a Regional Qualifying stage site on a pro rata basis.

If an applicant automatically eligible into the Final Qualifying stage withdraws after play has commenced in the Regional Qualifying stage (a "Final Qualifying stage Automatically Eligible Withdrawal"), the position reserved will be reallocated to the first available alternate from the various Regional Qualifying stage sites(s) determined in accordance with the following procedure: prior to conclusion of play in the Regional Qualifying stage, tournament competition personnel at Champions Tour Headquarters will conduct a blind clinical drawing to determine the order in which the alternates from the various Regional Qualifying stage sites will replace Final Qualifying stage Automatically Eligible Withdrawals.

V. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. RULES OF GOLF: Play shall be governed in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the United States Golf Association as modified by the Champions Tour. Questions and disputes shall be settled by the Rules Committee appointed by the Champions Tour Tournament Official on-site, whose decisions shall be final. There will be no refund of entry fee to disqualified players.

B. POSTPONEMENTS AND CANCELLATIONS: If, in the judgment of the on-site Champions Tour Tournament Official, adverse weather conditions or any other occurrence or condition renders commencement or continuation of tournament play inadvisable, play shall be postponed until such time as the Tournament Director determines that such weather conditions or other occurrence have improved sufficiently for play to commence or resume, provided that:

Regionals: Official tournament rounds are normally scheduled for Tuesday through Friday, and in all cases arrangements have been made with the host club to extend through Saturday in the event of postponements or suspensions.

Finals: Official tournament rounds are scheduled for Tuesday through Friday and arrangements have been made with the host club to extend through Saturday.

Completion of Qualifying competition shall not be postponed beyond Saturday, November 3 of Regionals and Saturday, November 17 of Finals unless the tournament is not yet considered "official" in accordance with Champions Tour *Tournament Regulations*. If, however, at least half of the field has completed play prior to the postponement of the final round, the final round will be completed when conditions permit. The decision to postpone or continue play shall be solely within the discretion of the Champions Tour Tournament Director, and such decision shall be final.

C. REMOVAL FROM COMPETITION: If a player is determined by Tournament Officials on-site at any stage of the Qualifying Tournament to be noncompetitive, Champions Tour reserves the right to remove said player from the competition, without any refund of entry fee.

D. APPEARANCE OF PLAYERS/CADDIES:

- 1) While on the host facility property during official practice and tournament round days players shall present a neat appearance in both clothing and personal grooming. Blue jeans, shorts or T-shirts shall not be worn.
- 2) Caddies may wear either long pants or tailored, solid-colored, knee-length shorts. Blue jeans, cutoffs or T-shirts shall not be worn. Smooth rubber sole shoes are required. Golf shoes with metal or soft spikes are prohibited.
- 3) A player must accept responsibility for the conduct of his caddie. A caddie who conducts himself/herself in an unbecoming manner could result in the removal of the player from the competition.

E. CADDIES:

Regionals: Players are not required to have a caddie, but have the option to have one should they elect. Each entrant is solely responsible for arranging and paying their own caddie.

Finals: All players are required to have a caddie. Each entrant is solely responsible for arranging and paying their own caddie.

F. GOLF CARTS: Unless conditions dictate otherwise as determined by the Champions Tour Tournament Official on-site, each player may have a cart. The player and caddie may ride together at any time. Walking scorers may ride if there is an open seat. No spectators may ride on the cart.

Pull carts: Manual and motorized pull carts are permitted in Regional stages. Pull carts are prohibited in both practice rounds and officials rounds at the Final Qualifying stage.

G. AMATEUR INFORMATION: Amateurs may enter the 2007 Champions Tour National Qualifying Tournament. Any amateur finishing among the top 30 and tied for 30th position at the Final Qualifying will forfeit amateur status upon entry in his first Event Qualifier during the next season.
